- Lake Planning Committee: Larry Pribyl gave an update from the Lake Planning Committee. The lake plan is a three-year plan to keep the lake healthy and deals with lakeshore, treatment of invasive species, fish stocking, and education. It is an important

document for getting grants approved for the lake. A draft of the lake plan will be available to the public for review and input in about two weeks.

- Membership: John Schneider provide an update for increasing membership. Currently we have 180 families who are members. There are 600 residences on the lake. A discussion was had on canvassing the nonmembers.
- New Board Members. Terry Cramer made an appeal for candidates for the board for the upcoming election.
- Annual Meeting: The annual meeting will be held Saturday, August 19, 2023 at the Namakagon Town Hall.
