Treasurer's Report

Walleye Report

Jeff Johnson provided an update on the walleye initiative. Since 2018, we have stocked over 40,000 extended length walleyes in the lake. We had a good harvest of eggs and milt this spring and have spent approximately \$13,000 spent on pinhead minnows so far this year with another \$12,000 in expense anticipated.

Invasive Species Report

Larry Pribyl gave an update on Hybrid Eurasian Milfoil in the lake and treatment. 36 acres were treated this year. Treatment areas were by Lakewood, Governors Island, Bluegill Bay and Mumm's Bay. A lake inspection report showed good results in the areas treated this year with PreCellaCor and a reoccurrence of growth in areas treated two years ago in the north part of the lake around Four Seasons and Mogasheen.

We have a 3 year, \$350,000 grant that covers 75% of the cost of treatment. The grant has a little left and we will reapply for a new grant if needed. Volunteer inspection reports help us cover the remaining 25% and member were encouraged to file reports on the NLA website.

Membership Report

Membership is currently at 500 members and 266 households. Last year's receipts were \$36,000 and we are on track to exceed that this year.

Social Events

Tomi Backlund gave an update on social events for the year and expressed our thanks to Amanda and Brandon at The Four Seasons and Travis and Heide at The Loon Saloon for hosting the events.
